An evaluation of the above-referenced property on 06/02/2017 revealed that the premises fails to comply with Section 12.79 of the Junk Motor Vehicle Ordinance of the City of Portland.

This is a Notice of Violation pursuant to Section 12.79 of the Code. All referenced violations shall be corrected within 30 days of the date of this notice. A re-inspection will occur on 07/03/2017, at which time compliance will be required. Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the Code and in Title 30-A M.R.S.A. Section 4452. This is an appealable decision pursuant to Section 12.80 of the Municipal Code.

ARTICLE V. JUNKED MOTOR VEHICLES*

Sec. 12-78. Placing on private property.

It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit, place, leave or abandon any old, discarded, worn out or junked motor vehicle, or parts thereof, on any private property in the city, except in duly authorized locations. (Code 1968, § 317.3)

Sec. 12-79. Keeping on private property; notice to remove.

It shall be unlawful for any person owning or occupying private property in the city to keep or allow to accumulate any old, discarded, worn out or junked motor vehicle, or parts thereof, on private property after having received written notice from the city, by the city manager or by an official designated by the city manager, ordering the removal from the property upon not less than thirty (30) days from receipt of the order of the old, discarded, worn out or junked motor vehicle, or parts thereof.

Comments:

6-2-2017. Two unregistered trucks with Maine commercial plates 758470; 3A6141 and one unregistered old school bus sitting in grass. All three vehicles are filled with trash and have trash debris surrounding them. The vehicles need to be removed or registered within 30 days.
