The main dance floor is 35 X 45 feet. The stage is 16 deep, I'm not sure about the width, but I think 19 or 20 ft. (The stage opening is 16 ft.) The small rooms to the west of the stage is the balance of the width of the building, minus the stairway on the east side. The front room (where the bar is) is 9 ft wide X 9' 4" deep. The ticket booth is 44" wide X 9' 4". Is that sufficient?
