Dear Mr. Goodell and Mr. Murray:

On July 22, 2014, the Portland Planning Board approved with conditions the change of use from a warehouse to a trampoline park at 921 Riverside Street. As provided in Section 14-532, this letter serves as the written permission from the Planning Authority to commence interior renovations prior to posting the performance guarantee for the walkway leading from the public sidewalk. The commencement of the interior work for the facility is limited to the extent of work outlined in the e-mail from Brian Christiansen, Project Manager for Trampoline Parks LLC and all applicable building or demolition permits must be obtained from the City's Inspection Division prior to commencing any work. The permission to proceed is subject to the following condition:

that the final site plans with the walkway, the performance guarantee and all site work must be submitted and completed prior to a certificate of occupancy.

Prior to the start of the site work for the walkway, a pre-construction meeting shall be held at the project site with the contractor, development review coordinator, Public Service's representative and owner to review the construction schedule, erosion and sedimentation controls, and other critical aspects of the site work. It shall be the contractor's responsibility to arrange a mutually agreeable time for the pre-construction meeting.

The approval to proceed with the interior renovation work is based on the submitted request of Mr. Brian Christiansen and the approved site plan with the condition of the sidewalk to be finalized and approved. If you need to make any modifications to the approved site plan, you must submit a revised site plan for staff review and approval.
