Hi Bob,

I am taking a first look at your permit application to construct a new 80' by 100' industrial building at 71 Caddie Lane. I just wanted to verify what the use of the building will be, because there are references to both "warehouse" and "indoor agriculture." Is the intent to use this building as a medical marijuana cultivation facility? If so, we would need some additional information from the grower, such as their state licensing. If they are going to build interior partitions, we would need plans for that as well.

If it's easier, we could permit this as a warehouse now, with the requirement that any future change-of-use, such as to a cultivation facility, will require a separate permit to be filed.
