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DRC Conditions of Approval

All damage to sidewalk, curb, street, or public utilities shall be repaired to City of Portland standards prior to issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy.

Two (2) City of Portland approved species and size trees must be planted on your street frontage prior to issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy.

Your new street address is now 174 Milton Street, , the number must be displayed on the street frontage of your house prior to issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy.

The Development Review Coordinator (874-8300 ext.8722) must be notified five (5) working days prior to date required for final site inspection. Please make allowances for completion of site plan requirements determined to be incomplete or defective during the inspection. This is essential as all site plan requirements must be completed and approved by the Development Review Coordinator prior to issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy. Please schedule any property closing with these requirements in mind.

Show all utility connections: water, sanitary, sewer, storm drain, electric, telephone, cable.

A sewer permit is required for you project. Please contact Carol Merritt at 874-8300, ext . 8828. The Wastewater and Drainage section of Public Works must be notified five (5) working days prior to sewer connection to schedule an inspector for your site.

A street opening permit(s) is required for your site. Please contact Carol Merritt ay 874-8300, ext. 8828. (Only excavators licensed by the City of Portland are eligible.)

As-built record information for sewer and stormwater service connections must be submitted to Public Works Engineering Section (55 Portland Street) and approved prior to issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy.

The building contractor shall check the subdivision recording plat for pre-determined first floor elevation and establish the first floor elevation (FFE) and sill elevation (SE) to be set above the finish street/curb elevation to allow for positive drainage away from entire footprint of building.

The site contractor shall establish finish grades at the foundation, bulkhead and basement windows to be in conformance with the first floor elevation (FFE) and sill elevation (SE) set by the building contractor to provide for positive drainage away from entire footprint of building.

A drainage plan shall be submitted to and approved by Development Review Coordinator showing first floor elevation (FFE), sill elevation (SE), finish street/curb elevation, lot grading, existing and proposed contours, drainage patterns and paths, drainage swales, grades at or near abutting property lines, erosion control devices and locations and outlets for drainage from the property.

The Development Review Coordinator reserves the right to require additional lot grading or other drainage improvements as necessary due to field conditions.

Applicant shall be responsible for all installation and maintenance of necessary erosion control measures. Also applicant shall minimize and be responsible to sweep all tracking of mud onto city streets.

The applicant shall coordinate with Diversified Properties, Inc. and their general contractor A. H. Grover for the completion of grading, utility services and driveway location to insure compliance with the approved subdivision plan and completed construction.
