1.4 PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS

A. Flame spread under 25 B. "R" Value 12

1.5 SUBMITTALS

- A. Submit product data under provision of Section 01340.
- B. Submit a complete frame schedule, large scale details of frame construction, indicating thickness of materials, reinforcing, cutouts and method of anchorage.
- C. Do not fabricate fiberglass reinforced plastic frames without final shop drawing review.
- D. Submit color chart indicating full color range for color selection by the Engineer.
- E. Submit for review a complete detailed finish hardware schedule. The finish hardware schedule shall contain a listing of the name of each manufacturer and the product listing for the series included in the hardware schedule.
- F. Provide catalog cuts on specified hardware.
- G. Provide manufacturer's installation instructions.

H. Submit manufacturer's certificate that frames meet or exceed specified requirements.

1.6 **QUALIFICATIONS**

- A. Manufacturer's company specializing in the manufacture of the products specified in this section with a minimum of 12 standard colors available.
- B. The Fiberglass Reinforced Doors Section 08220, Steel Doors and Frames Section 08110, and the Finished Hardware Section 08710 shall be provided by single supplier.

1.7 <u>DELIVERY, STORAGE AND HANDLING</u>

- A. Deliver all materials to the site in sealed, undamaged containers with the manufacturer's name, project number, tag location, door type and color.
- B. Store materials in original cartons, on edge in such a way to prevent falling or damage to face, corners and edges.

1.8 <u>WARRANTY</u>

- A. Guarantee frames against failure due to corrosion for five (5) years from time of purchase.
- B. Guarantee closers for five (5) years from date of completion and acceptance of building.
- C. Installation shall be the responsibility of the General Contractor.

1.9 <u>MAINTENANCE SERVICE</u>

- A. Provide special wrenches and tools applicable to each different or special hardware component.
- B. Provide maintenance tools and accessories supplied by hardware component manufacturer.

PART 2 - PRODUCTS

2.1 MANUFACTURERS

- A. Warminster Fiberglass
- B. Fiberglass Technology, Inc.
- C. Or equivalent.

2.2 MATERIALS

A. Frames shall be fiberglass reinforced plastic.

2.3 FRAMES

- A. Door frame with stop and window frame with stop shall be molded in one piece.
- B. Reinforcing members shall be factory installed.

2.4 <u>HARDWARE</u>

- A. All hardware within the door or frame shall be factory installed.
- B. Provide scheduled hardware as specified in Section 08710.

PART 3 - EXECUTION

3.1 <u>EXAMINATION</u>

- A. Verify that openings are ready to receive work.
- B. Verify field measurements are as shown on Drawings.
- C. Beginning of installation means installer accepts existing surface conditions.

3.2 INSTALLATION

A. Installation shall be in strict compliance with manufacturer's written instructions.
