Application Check List:

At the time of application, instructions for uploading the plans will be provided to the applicant. One paper set of the plans, written materials and application fee must be submitted to the Planning Division Office to start the review process.

Refer to the application checklist for a detailed list of submittal requirements.

Portland's development review process and requirements are outlined in the Land Use Code (Chapter 14), which includes the Subdivision Ordinance (Section 14-491) and the Site Plan Ordinance (Section 14-521). Portland's Land Use Code is on the City's web site: www.portlandmaine.gov Copies of the ordinances may be purchased through the Planning Division. All of the information on the checklist must be submitted for review. The applicant must check off the items contained in the application package to ensure the application is complete.


Property Taxes:

Separate Permits:

Separate permits are required for internal and external plumbing, HVAC, and electrical installations.
