The price quoted includes the standard system being installed on site by local licensed installers of TFPP/Pyro-Chem® after the booth is erected.

The system includes:

- Dry Chemical cylinders
- Control heads
- O Nozzles
- Fusible links/detectors
- D Pulleys/tees
- U Wire rope and alarm bells based on the size booth purchased.

The standard installation cost does not include:

- Chemical distribution pipe, conduit for electrical and detection, and miscellaneous parts needed to connect pipe or conduit. (These materials vary depending upon the size and location of the installed booth.)
- I All Permitting cost.
- Electrical or alarm connections to the system for shut down and alarm purposes. This must be completed by a certified electrician or alarm company.
- Customers in remote locations may incur additional installation travel fees.
- I Final Test Fees for certification when applicable.
