RE: Temporary Certificate of Occupancy for 83 Shephard Lane

I have reviewed the single family residence at 83 Shephard Lane and believe it would be acceptable to issue a temporary Certificate of Occupancy. A permanent Certificate of Occupancy should not be issued until the following conditions have been met.

- 1. At the time of my inspection, the ground surface was covered with 12-15" of snow making it difficult to review the lot grading. It appears that some additional lot grading will be necessary in the spring. As a result, the final lot grading shall be completed and approved by the DRC by May 15, 1995.
- 2. The disturbed lot area shall be loamed, seeded and mulched no later than May 15, 1995 and approved by the Development Review Coordinator.
- 3. Two City of Portland approved species and size trees must be planted along the street frontage prior to issuance of a permanent Certificate of Occupancy. Trees shall also be approved by the DRC and planted by May 15, 1995.
