Conditions:

1) Hardwired photoelectric interconnected battery backup smoke detectors shall be installed in all sleeping rooms, protecting outside these rooms, and on every level.

The same is required for existing buildings, where permanent wiring is feasible; or at the very least battery operated smoke detectors are required. Verification of this will be upon inspection.

- 2) Window sills in locations more than 72 inches from finished grade shall be a minimum of 24 inches above the finished floor of the room, unless a window fall prevention devices is installed in accordance with section IRC Sec. R612.3 or IBC Sec. 1405.13.2.
- 3) Tempered safety glazing is required at all hazardous locations per IRC 2009 Sec. R308.4 and IBC 2009 Sec. 2406.4
- 4) Carbon Monoxide (CO) alarms shall be installed in each area within or giving access to sleeping rooms. That detection must be powered by the electrical service (plug-in or hardwired) in the building and battery.
- 5) If there are 4 or more risers, a handrail is required on one side of stairs with ends returned if the guardrail does not meet graspability dimensions. A 2x4 is not considered graspable. One handrail is required on ramps exceed a pitch of 12:1.
- 6) Connections and Fasteners to be installed per 2009 IBC Sec. 2304.9 and/or IRC Table R602.3(1)
- 7) Beams & girders shall be solid or built up and bear on wood or supported by approved anchors per IBC Sec. 2308.7 and IRC R502.6
- 8) This permit is approved based upon information provided by the applicant or design professional. Any deviation from the final approved plans requires separate review and approval prior to work.
