

Wolf, owner, requests the Board to reconsider its action on a variance, Section 14-473(c)(1). Since an applicant is required to meet all four variance criteria in order to obtain a variance, the applicant's petition for relief from the maximum allowable expansion of 30 percent to either floor area or volume, under Section 14-382, [14-322] did not pass. R-3 Zone
