With the issuance of this permit, the owner, builder or their designee is required to provide adequate notice to the City of Portland Inspections Division for the inspections listed below. Appointments must be requested 48 to 72 hours in advance. The inspection date will need to be confirmed by this office.

- **Please read the conditions of approval that are attached to this permit.**
- **Permits expire in 6 months if the project is not started or ceases for 6 months.**
- **If the inspection requirements below are not followed, then additional fees may be incurred due to the issuance of a "Stop Work Order" and subsequent release to continue.**
- **Per Section 107.3.1 of the Maine Uniform Building and Energy Code (MUBEC), one set of printed approved stamped construction documents will be kept at the site of work and open to inspection by building officials.**

The project cannot move to the next phase prior to the required inspection and approval to continue.

At the completion of construction, a stamped letter shall be submitted verifying substantial compliance with the approved structural design and any applicable test results. This is required prior to the final inspection and occupancy or a Certificate of Occupancy.</li> <li>5) This permit is approved based upon information provided by the design professional.
