With the issuance of this permit, the owner, builder or their designee is required to provide adequate notice to the city of Portland Inspections Services for the following inspections. Appointments must be requested 48 to 72 hours in advance of the required inspection. The inspection date will need to be confirmed by this office.

- **Permits expire in 6 months. If the project is not started or ceases for 6 months.**
- **If the inspection requirements are not followed as stated below additional fees may be incurred due to the issuance of a "Stop Work Order" and subsequent release to continue.**
- **Per Section 107.3.1 of the Maine Uniform Building and Energy Code (MUBEC). One set of printed approved stamped construction documents shall be kept at the site of work and shall be open to inspection by building officials.**

Conditions:				
1) Installation shall be in accordance with the City of Portland Fire Department Regulations and NFPA 13 as published.				
2) Installation shall be in accordance with the City of Portland Fire Department Regulations and NFPA 13 as published. A copy of the State Sprinkler permit with RMS date and signature and the Contractor's Material and Test Certificate for Aboveground Piping (NFPA 13 figure 24.1) shall be provided prior to scheduling of the final inspection.				
3) A sprinkler supervisory system shall be provided in accordance with NFPA 101, Life Safety Code, and NFPA 72, National Fire Alarm and Signaling Code. Sprinkler supervisory systems shall monitor for water flow and sprinkler supervisory signals via an approved fire alarm panel to central station. One smoke detector shall be located over the panel, a manual pull station located at the front door, and an audible water flow alarm provided. A separate fire alarm permit is required from a certified fire alarm company.				
4) A 4100 series Knox Box is required.				
5) Notice: The first scheduled final inspection fee is at no charge. Additional inspections shall be billed at \$75 for each inspector.				
6) The entire sprinkler system shall be maintained in accordance with NFPA 25, Standard for Inspection, Testing and Maintenance of Water-Based Fire Protection Systems, 2008 edition. This applies to the entire building and a letter must be submitted to the Fire Prevention Office, attn: Capt. Pirone before a final inspection is scheduled. The intent of this requirement is to verify code compliance for the entire building.				
7) System acceptance and commissioning must be coordinated with a fire alarm technician and suppression system contractors and the Fire Department. Call 874-8400 to schedule.				
8) Signage complying with NFPA 13 Chapter 7.7.1.5 shall be located above FDC indicating what type of system and which building it is protecting.				
9) Fire department connection shall be two 2 1/2" inlets unless the riser is 3" or less.(NFPA 1963, Standard For fire Hose Connections.)				
10 Pay special attention in the following NFPA 13 Chapters:				
1.Chapter 6.7.4 Identification of Valves				
2.Chapter 7.7.1.5 Signs				
3.Chapter 8.17.2.4.7 Signs.				
11 Shall comply with 2009 NFPA 1 Chapter 13 Fire Protection Systems.
