Job Description:

Rebuild of deck to expanded size -- currently 8' by 10' going to 10' by 12'

Steps:

- 1. John Hutchings to remove existing deck and contractor will remove and dispose
- 2. Contractor, Pete Peters / Donalco, to remove any siding or trim needed to allow proper flashing of deck and save for re-use
- 3. Utilize existing two concrete sauna tubes that are 10" inches below grade and 4' feet from building anchorage of column to footing with simpson anchor tie
- 4. Contractor to frame new deck using pressure treated lumber and using -
 - a. ledger size attached to building 2" by 10"
 - b. lag bolt size 3/8" by 5" and spacing on ledger 16" on center
 - c. flashing where deck meets home
 - d. girder size and spans carrying floor system 2" by 10"
 - e. joist size 2" by 8"; span 10' and spacing 16" on center
 - f. joist hangers
 - g. deck sizing 5 1/4" by 6" pt 12'
- 5. Contractor to install new railing with square balusters 4" spacing and 42" handrail
- 6. Contractor to build 3 stairs 40 1/2" wide, 11" tread with 7" riser and 3/4 to 1" nosing.
- 7. Contractor to re-install any siding or trim removed for deck installation and use new pieces if needed
- 8. Contractor to remove all debris created from this project
- 11. Cost of deck build is \$1,850
