
Dear Mr. Handyman,

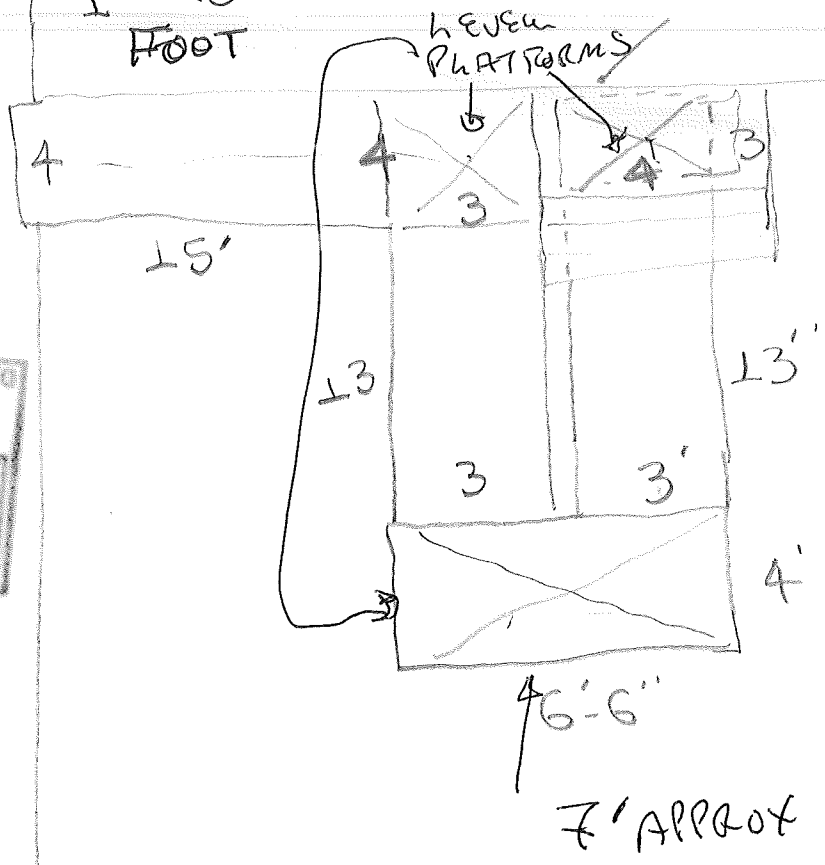

FOOT

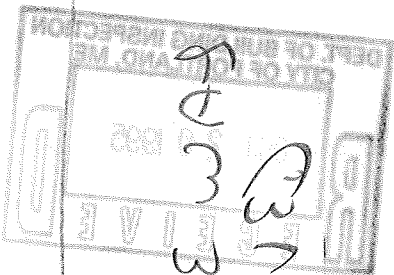


2x6 PRESSURE @16
