Dear Mr. Usher,

Upon a recent inspection at the above referenced address, on 8/5/98 revealed the following violations and unsafe conditions which shall be corrected, pursuant to NEC 1996 and all applicable codes. We discussed these issues via a phone conversation that very day, and you had indicated that the landlord, a.k.a. SHAW'S, would take full responsibility for the violations and bring the space into compliance. Here is the list, in writing, as you requested.

MAIN STORE AREA:

- 1. Support all of the wiring above the suspended ceilings with approved methods. ART: 300-11
- 2. Clip or support the florescent drop-in fixtures with approved methods. ART: 410-16(c)
- 3. Support all junction boxes. ART: 300-11
- 4. Check for open junction boxes or open splices. ART: 300-15(b) & 110-3(a)1-8

REAR OFFICE AREA:

- 1. ROMEX type cables shall not penetrate ceiling tiles. Install EMT conduit to above the ceiling and adapt it to the ROMEX with approved methods. **ART: 300-21**
- 2. Re-label the electrical panel with a typed panel schedule. ART: 384-13

These violations and unsafe conditions shall be completed prior to obtaining a C of O from this office. Our policy is and shall be, to require that new and renovated spaces meet all applicable electrical codes, and be made safe, as is possible.
