- A. Conditional Use Appeal: <u>7 Kensington Street</u>, Erin Campbell, tenant, Susan Campbell, owner, Tax Map 431, Block H, Lot 001, R-5 Residential Zone: The applicant is seeking a Conditional Use approval under Section 14-410(c) for a home occupation as a permanent makeup artist. The home occupation would be in her residence, which is one unit of a twofamily dwelling. Representing the appeal is the tenant. *The Board of Appeals voted 5-0 to grant the Conditional Use approval for a home occupation as a permanent makeup artist.*
- **B.** Conditional Use Appeal: <u>15 Morningstar Lane</u>, Dianne and Matt Watters, buyers, Frederick and Colleen Writt, owners, Tax Map 385A, Block A, Lot 032, R-2 Residential Zone: The applicants are seeking a Conditional Use Appeal under Section 14-78(a)(2) to create an accessory dwelling unit within a partially-completed single-family home. Representing the appeal are the buyers. *The Board of Appeals voted 5-0 to grant the Conditional Use approval for an accessory dwelling unit within the currently partially-completed single-family home. The approval is valid for two years.*
