Dear Ms. Gulliver,

On January 9, 1997, Jim Wendel reviewed the single family residence at 3 Alice Street for compliance with conditions of approval dated July 23, 1996. All the conditions have NOT been met. The following needs to be completed:

1. The street address number needs to be placed on the house.
2. A copy of the sewer permit needs to be submitted the the Development Review Coordinator as proof that Public Works has the necessary data.
3. Two City of Portland approved trees need be planted.
4. Once snow has melted and there is exposed earth, all disturbed areas need to be stabilized with a heavy application of hay mulch and then loam and seeded in the spring.
5. A wooden fence or barrier needs to be installed between the easement and the lot drive.

The following Building Code Requirements need to be completed:

1. Permanent, code compliant stairs/ramps, front and rear, will be constructed no later than June 1, 1997.
2. A smooth and traversable walkway leading the the public way will be completed no later than June 1, 1997.

The following Electrical Code Conditions need to be completed within ten (10) days of this letter date:

1. Type panel schedule.
2. Clip electrical service conduit at meter.
3. Install clips at meter for SE cable.
4. Change all boxes for keyless fixtures. Basement and garage.
5. Install all outside lighting and GFCI outlets.
6. Wires bundled in one connector at panel
7. Change metal plates in garage to plastic.
