

With the issuance of this permit, the owner, builder or their designee is required to provide adequate notice to the city of Portland Inspections Services for the following inspections. Appointments must be requested 48 to 72 hours in advance of the required inspection. The inspection date will need to be confirmed by this office.

- Please read the conditions of approval that is attached to this permit!! Contact this office if you have any questions.
- Permits expire in 6 months. If the project is not started or ceases for 6 months.
- If the inspection requirements are not followed as stated below additional fees may be incurred due to the issuance of a "Stop Work Order" and subsequent release to continue.
- Per Section 107.3.1 of the Maine Uniform Building and Energy Code (MUBEC). One set of printed approved stamped construction documents shall be kept at the site of work and shall be open to inspection by building officials.

 Conditions: 1) Where supported by attachment to an exterior wall, decks shall be positively anchored to the primary structure and designed for both vertical and lateral loads as applicable. Such attachment shall not be accomplished by the use of toenails or nails subject to withdrawal. 				
Deck lateral load connection shall be allowed with hold-down tension devices installed in not less than two locations per deck, with each device having an allowable stress design capacity of not less than 1500 pounds.				
Where positive connection to the primary building structure cannot be verified during inspection, decks shall be self- supporting.				
2) Hardwired photoelectric interconnected battery backup smoke detectors shall be installed in all bedrooms, protecting the bedrooms, and on every level in the addition. The same is required for the existing building, where permanent wiring is feasible; or at the very least battery operated smoke detectors are required. Verification of this will be upon inspection.				
3) Separate permits are required for any electrical, plumbing, sprinkler, fire alarm, HVAC systems, heating appliances, including pellet/wood stoves, commercial hood exhaust systems and fuel tanks. Separate plans may need to be submitted for approval as a part of this process.				
 Any modifications to existing building systems and all new systems (HVAC, electrical, plumbing) shall meet IECC 2009 or ASHRAE 90.1-2007 requirements for energy code compliance. 				
 Beams & girders shall be solid or built up and bear on wood or supported by approved anchors per IBC Sec. 2308.7 and IRC R502.6 				
6) Carbon Monoxide (CO) alarms shall be installed in each area within or giving access to bedrooms. That detection must be powered by the electrical service (plug-in or hardwired) in the building and battery.
