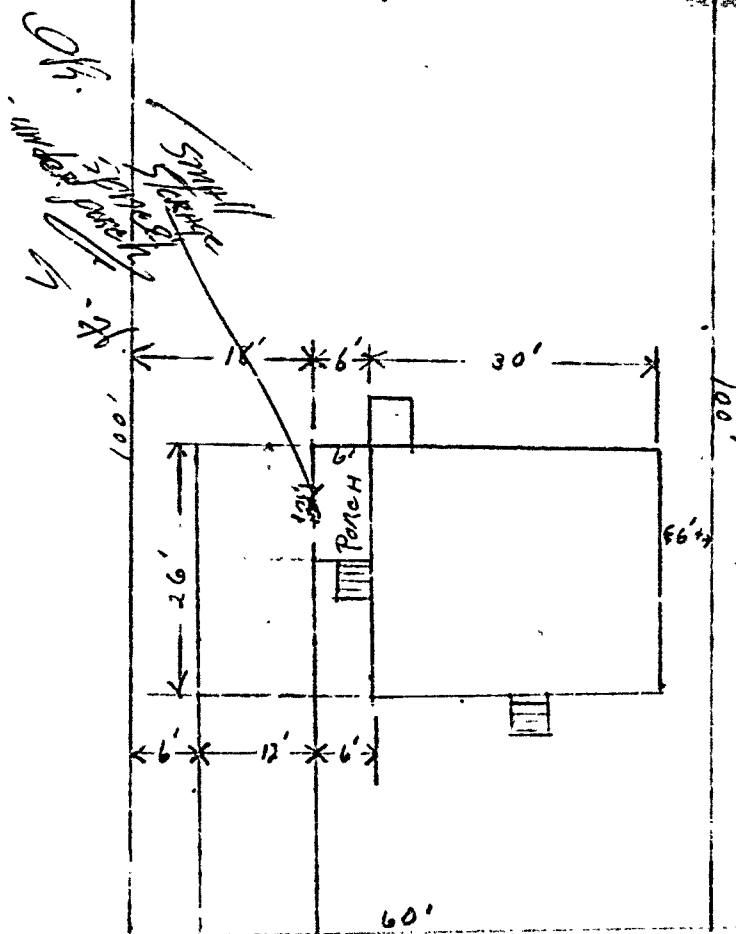

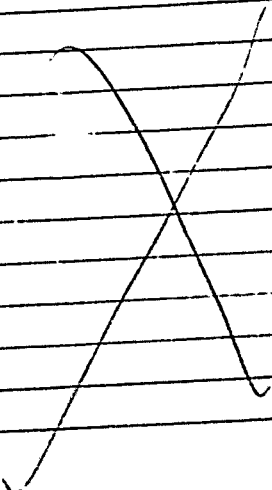

To the Board of Appeals:

Your appellant, Francis Coyne, who is the owner of property at 192-194 Ray Street, respectfully petitions the Board of Appeals of the City of Portland to permit an exception to the regulations of the Zoning Ordinance relating to this property, as provided by Section 18 of said Zoning Ordinance.

Permit for construction of a single family dwelling 26 feet by 30 feet at 192-194 Ray Street is not issuable because the lot on which it is to be erected has a width of only 60 feet instead of the 65 feet specified by Section 4-B-10 of the Zoning Ordinance and an area of only 6000 square feet instead of the 6500 square feet specified by Sections 4-B-8 & 9 of that Ordinance, these requirements applying to the R-3 Residence Zone in which the property is located.

The facts and conditions which make this exception legally permissible are as follows:

An exception is necessary in this case to grant reasonable use of property and can be granted without substantially departing from the intent and purpose of the Zoning Ordinance.

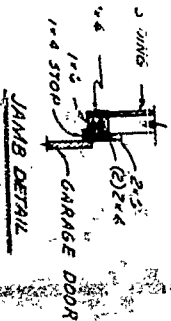
STUD & RAFTER LAYOUT

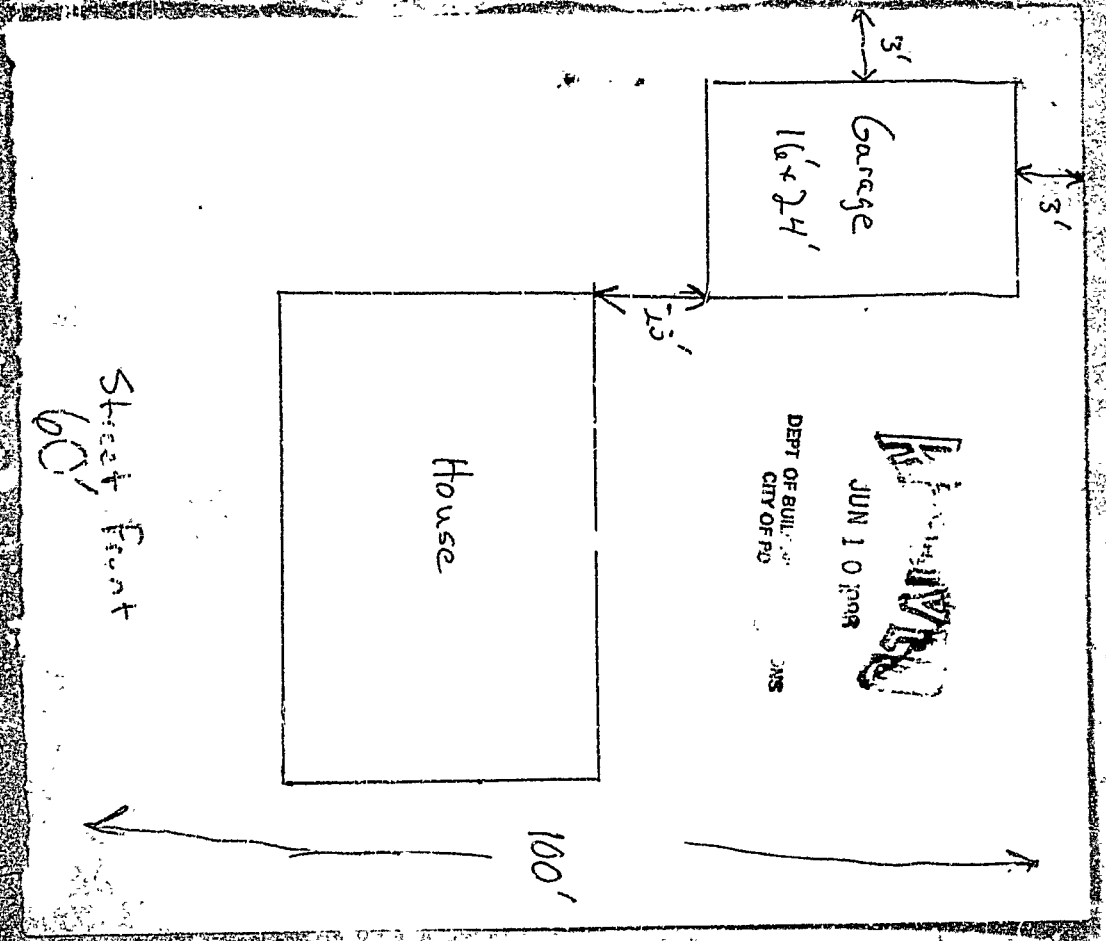
