Hello Laurie,

I have attached the revisions and I was a little confused as to what the file name should be so I hope I haven't frustrated you. Anyway, I made the notations on the drawing. The windows meet egress, there is NOT a bathroom window, although we are installing an exhaust vent to the exterior. We MAY need to adjust fixture location slightly to accommodate/ facilitate access to appropriate drain below, however, our Master Plumber, Rick Galipeau and I will make sure all fixture locations are appropriate with regard to local code requirements. Stair rise/run is compliant as well as rail heights/spacing. Main area ceiling height is north of 12'-6" so I know that we comply with headroom requirements no problem. The area OVER the stairs is super high as well. All good.

Looking forward to getting it done right.
