General Description

Our dwelling at 37 Ice Pond Drive is a new construction in a new subdivision. The existing daylight basement has windows and a door opening to the back yard. Currently, the basement is unfinished and per the proposed plan, we would build standard frame partitions with sheetrock to provide separate storage, office and recreational space and a small bath. The resulting rooms would be wired and heated with baseboard electric heat. All work is to be done by licensed personnel according to code and would be entirely contained within the existing basement area. None of the work would change the footprint of the house nor would the new walls be structural.
