To whom it may concern,

I am requesting a permit to allow me the use of my residence at 147 Veranda Street for a home occupation. I intend to practice massage therapy as allowed by item (b) 9 of section 14-410 of the Portland zoning ordinance. The following is an explanation of how my home occupation meets the criteria listed under item (a) of the same.

- 1. My home occupation is 165 square feet (19%) of floor area of the residence
- 2. No goods will be stored or displayed or be visible from outside the residence
- 3. Storage of materials are minimal and will be kept within the office space
- 4. Exterior signage will be limited to small placard in window of entryway door.
- 5. No alterations to residence will be made
- 6. There is off street parking in the driveway behind the residence
- 7. There will be no noise created by practicing massage therapy
- 8. I will have no employees
- 9. I will be seeing one client at a time and only up to 4 per day. This does not increase local traffic beyond the norm
- 10. No large vehicles will be arriving at the residence

As you can see, my home occupation is a secondary and incidental use of my residence. The external activity level and impact is negligible and in keeping with the residential character of the neighborhood.

Attached you will find a copy of the floor plan indicating the space to be used for an office as well as a letter from the owner giving me permission to conduct a home occupation. Thank-you for your assistance in this matter.
