Any change of use shall require a separate permit application for review and approval. 2) This approves the repair or rebuild of entry steps within the existing non-conforming footprint or with a slight expansion toward the road in order to meet code, not to exceed 6". 3) This is being issued with the understanding that as a fast track, the owner is responsible for scheduling inspections for the work being done and the inspector may require modifications to the work that has been completed if it does not meet code. 4) This permit is being approved on the basis of plans submitted.
