As requested, this letter is confirmation that the roof structure for the Bayside Village Project located in Portland, Maine has been designed to support isolated mechanical equipment.


The roof mounted mechanical equipment includes seven exhaust fans with an approximate weight of 50 pounds each and four makeup air units with an approximate weight of 1600 pounds each. The size and weights of the roof mounted equipment were provided by Thayer Corporation on August 10, 2007.

The location of the makeup air units is indicated on drawing S1.6 of the Construction Drawings for this project. Since the weight of the exhaust fans is small in comparison to the design loads, their locations on the roof are not limited.
