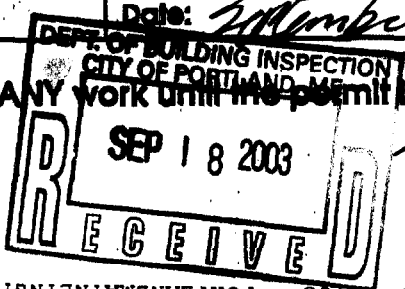

Tent Layout

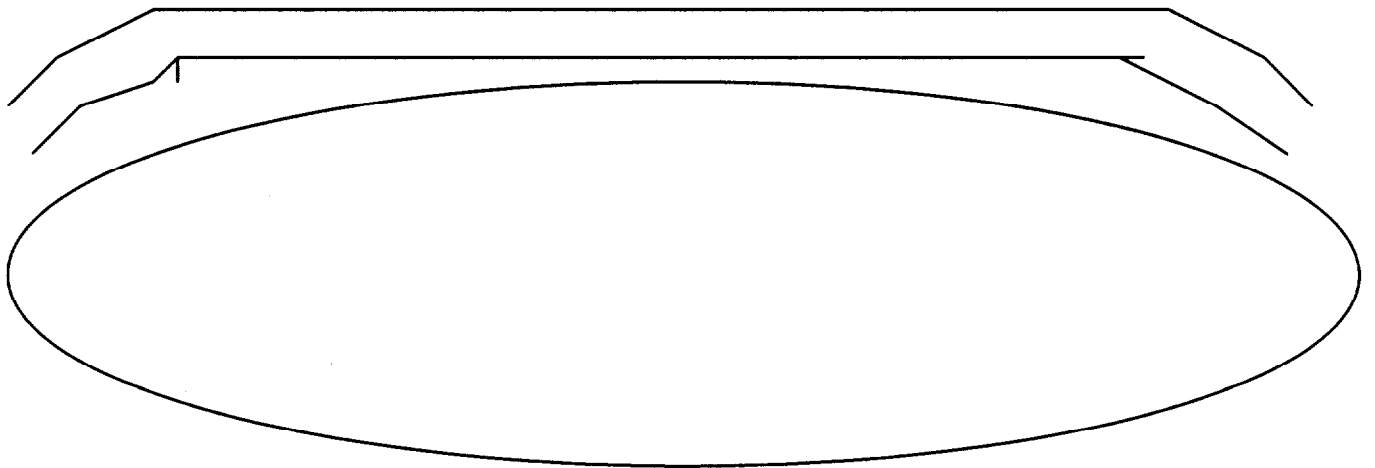
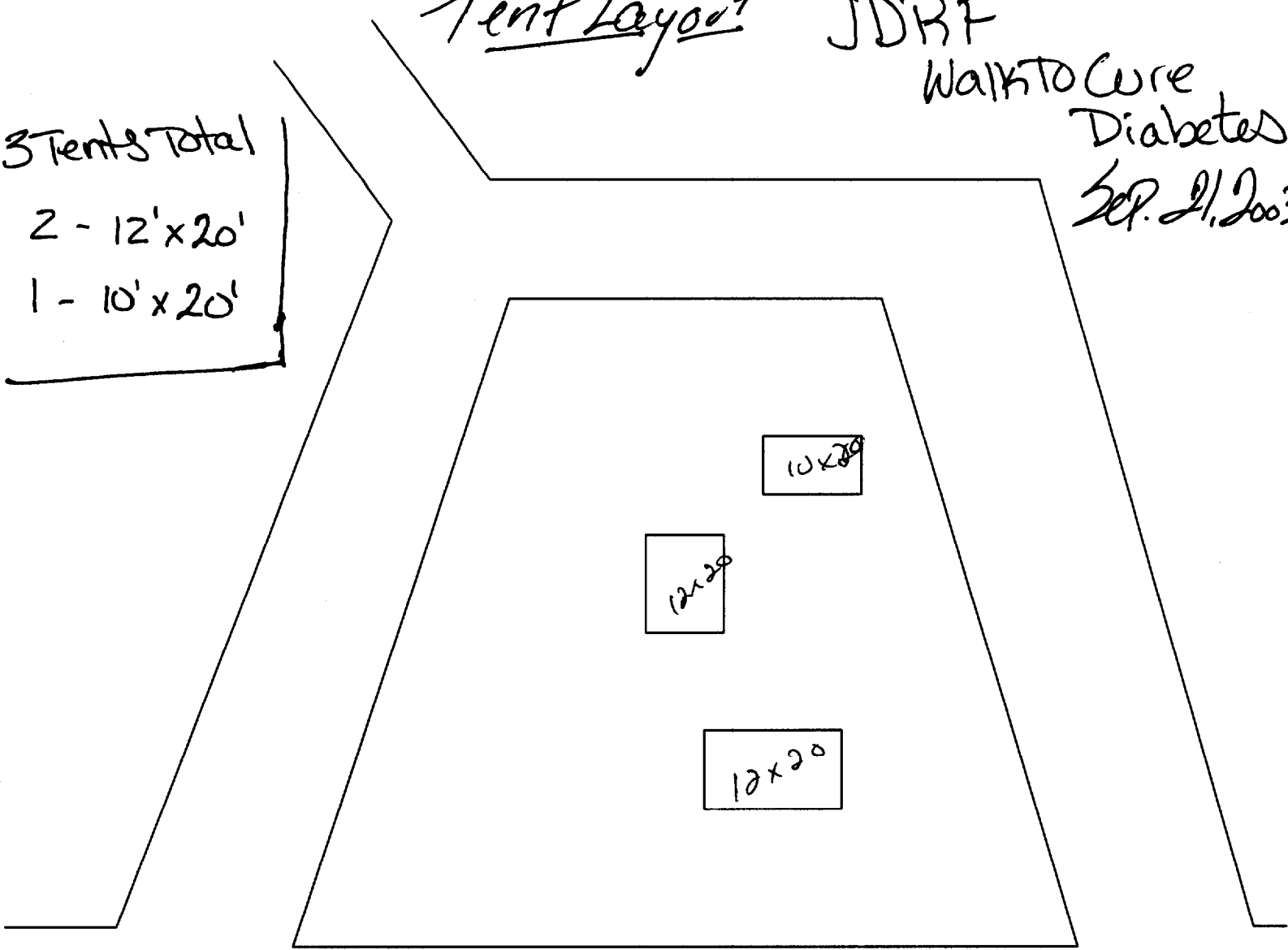



For both the covered and exposed canopy frames, side winds control the wind capacities of the gable frames when the guy wires are installed at 45 degrees to the end walls of the canopy. If the guy wires are not installed in this manner, then headwinds become the controlling mode of failure for the exposed frames, at a lower wind speed.

Based on our analysis of the selected frames discussed above, we conclude the following:

- The Original King Canopy frames are capable of withstanding approximately 5 psf snow load and 45 mph winds with the roof covering in place. With the roof covering removed and the frames exposed, the frames are capable of withstanding approximately 65 mph sustained winds.
- The Universal Canopy frames are capable of withstanding approximately 5 psf snow load and 40 mph winds with the roof covering in place. With the roof covering removed and the frames exposed, the frames are capable of withstanding approximately 60 mph sustained winds.

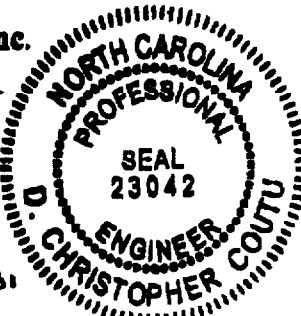
