- ယ performance guarantee will be released. A defect guarantee, consisting of 10% of the performance guarantee, must be posted before the
- 4. representatives. It shall be the contractor's responsibility to arrange a mutually agreeable time for construction schedule and critical aspects of the site work. At that time, the site/building the preconstruction meeting. contractor shall provide three (3) copies of a detailed construction schedule to the attending City development review coordinator, Public Work's representative and owner to review the Prior to construction, a preconstruction meeting shall be held at the project site with the contractor,

Please contact Carol Merritt at 874-8300, ext. 8828. (Only excavators licensed by the City of Portland are eligible.)
- Ġ all site plan requirements must be completed and approved by the Development Review required for final site inspection. Please make allowances for completion of site plan closing with these requirements in mind. Coordinator prior to issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy. Please schedule any property requirements determined to be incomplete or defective during the inspection. This essential as The Development Review Coordinator must be notified five (5) working days prior to date
