Dear Manager:

I wish to file a complaint about food service at Gilbert's restaurant in Westland. I visited on the 6th of July while in your fair city, for a late lunch. By 8am on the 7th I had expensive diarrhea. I came in to the restaurant with a group from a convention I attended. The bases of my complaint are several:

- a staff member invited us to sit at one of several empty tables. Dirty dishes had been cleared, but food scraps had not been removed. I had to ask.
- my crab cake was a greasy patty. It was not hot. (It was almost tasteless. (160°F min))
- my sea food chowder was not hot.
- one lunch mate ordered a salad that had shrimp mixed in. They were old enough to be almost tasteless
- I had to find a staffer to get my bill. I looked in the kitchen and noticed that the chowder was being served from crock pots. A cook will keep any/gumbo warm if given several hours head start. I doubt if they are appropriate for a restaurant where one would have to refill the crock several times during lunch.
