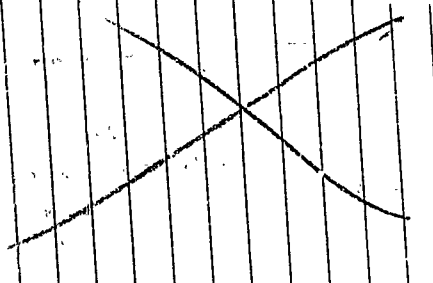

Upon examination of the building which you are reported to own on Murray Lane, Off Washington Avenue, we find that the chimney in the rear end story all is leaning badly above the roof and requires topping out.

Please arrange to have this chimney repaired above the roof on or before August 15, 1933, this direction being given as authorized by Section 11 of the Building Code of the City of Portland, copy attached hereto.

You will be expected to remove the top of this chimney far enough down to reach sound work. If this means removing any part of the chimney below the roof, a building permit is required from this office. If all the chimney flues in the building are not equipped with a cast iron clean-out door and frame at the bottom of each flue, they should be so equipped at this time.

Please be governed accordingly.
