Dear Sir:

We find that the building formerly used as a dwelling house, now vacant, located on Murray Lane at the rear of 83 Washington Avenue is in a dilapidated and dangerous condition. Doors and windows are open in such a way that any person may enter the building at will on misadventure.

Such a condition is considered a dangerous and inflammable one as indicated in Section 54 of Chapter 35, Revised Statutes of Maine, copy attached hereto. You are accordingly directed to have this dangerous and inflammable condition corrected on or before June 26th, 1934.

It seems apparent after examination of the building that the building will never be used for habitation again. Under these circumstances, it is likely that you may prefer to have the building demolished and the site cleared up. If such is your desire, it is quite likely that this Department may be able to direct you to some man who may possibly be willing to remove the building and clear up the site for the material that he could get out of it without any cost to you. If we can be of service in this way, please make request at this office at some time during the Inspector's office hours named above.
