



Dear Sire

We find that the building formerly used as a dwelling house, now vacant, located on kurray Lane at the rear of 83 Washington Avenue is in a dilapidated and dangerous condition. Exers and windows are op in such a way that any person may enter the building at will on miscusef bent.

Such a condition is considered a dangerous and inflammable one as indicated in Section S4 of Chapter 35, Revised Statutes of Maine, copy attached hereto. You are accordingly directed to have this dangerous and inflammable condition corrected in or before June 26th, 1934.

It seems apparent after exertation of the building that the building will never be used or habitation again. Under these circumstances, it is likely that you may prefer to have the building demolished and the site cleared up. If such is your desire, it is quite likely that this Department may be able to direct you to some men who may possibly be willing to remove the building and clear up the site for the material that he could get out of it without may cost to you. If we can be of service in this way, please make request at this office at some time during the Inspector's office hours named above.
