Gentlemen:

An inspector from this department reports that the oil-burning forced hot water heating system, for installation of which a permit application was filed on May 14th, has already been installed without a permit, which is of course in violation of the Building Code. He reports that the smokepipe from the heater passes only about 4 inches below a girder and about 6 inches below the first floor timbers. While protective shields have been provided, their construction does not meet Code requirements for the small clearances involved.

In order to comply with Code requirements, it is necessary that a shield consisting of 22 gauge sheet metal on one-inch rock-wool batts reinforced with wire or equivalent be provided. We shall expect this to be done without delay. Please give notification when this has been done, so that another inspection can be made. Issuance of permit will be withheld until a satisfactory shield has been provided.
