Dear Mr. Silver:

From the fact that smoke escapes from the <sup>front</sup> chimney at second floor level or above in the building which you are reported to own or control at 73 Atlantic Street, it appears that defects in the chimney wall or smokepipe connections are likely. It also appears that the true condition cannot be observed by casual inspection from the room or rooms in which the smoke appears.

Under State Law and the Building Code of Portland it is necessary for me to require that you make examination or have examination made of this chimney to find what causes the trouble and to proceed to correct any defects found in permanent fashion without delay.

If your examination of the situation seems to establish that the leakage of smoke is caused other than by defects in the chimney or smokepipe connections, it is important that you convey to Inspector Thurlow of this office what your theory is and what remedy you think will meet the needs before October 30, 1951.

In event it appears to you that defects in the chimney or smokepipe connections are the cause of the leakage, it is necessary that you cover sufficient of the chimney wall to disclose the defects and when they have been found, notify Inspector Thurlow or leave a message at the office for him, of readiness of inspection. If the defects have been found, he will go with you to the building if you will notify him.

If the chimney is found defective, requiring repairs to the chimney inside of the building (below the roof), a permit is required from this department before the repairs are started.
