The above mentioned conditions are in violation of Article V of the Municipal Code of the City of Portland, Maine, and must be corrected on or before August 29, 1993 . Failure to comply with this order may result in a complaint being filed for prosecution in District Court.

As owner or agent of the property located at the above referenced address, you are horeby notified that as the result of a recent inspection, the apartment (Apt 2/2nd fi) is hereby declared an environmental lead hazard for children under the age of seven.

Due to a lead paint hazard, this vacant apartment (Apt 2/2nd fl) must be kept vacant from occupancy of children under the age of seven so long as the following conditions continue to exist thereon.

Article v Seution 6-120 Properties which are either damage?, dilapidated, insanitary, unsafe, or vermin-infested in such a manner as to create a serious hazard to the bealth, safety, and general welfare of the occupants or the public.

Therefore, you will not occupy, permit anyone to occupy, or rent the above mentioned unit to families with children under the age of seven without the written consent of the Health Officer or his agent.
