STRUCTURAL

Repair and put in good order all dilapidated and hazardous parts of the structure as follows:

- 1. Repair or replace the cracked, loose, or missing plaster on the ceilings of the bathroom of the first floor apartment, and the kitchen and dining room of the second floor apartment.

Our inspection reveals that the attic rooms are not fit for human occupancy and cannot be rented until it complies with the Housing Code of the City of Portland.

We suggest that you make the exterior walls of the structure weather tight and water tight by painting or any other suitable means.

The above mentioned conditions are in violation of Chapter 217 of the Municipal Code of the City of Portland, and must be corrected on or before July 30, 1963.
