

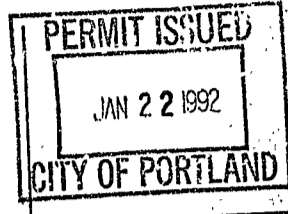


A recent inspection was made by Code Enforcement Officer Arthur Addato of the property owned by you at 47-49 Boyd Street, Portland, Maine. As a result of the inspection, you are ordered to correct the following conditions that exist: Unlawful Change of Use


103.2 Change in use: It shall be unlawful to make any change in the use or occupancy of any structure or portion thereof which would subject it to any special provisions of this code without approval of the building official, and the building official's certification that such structure meets the intent of the provisions of law governing building construction for the proposed new use and occupancy, and that such change does not result in any greater hazard to public safety or welfare.

The above mentioned conditions are in violation of Section 103.2 of the 1981 BOCA Building Code, and must be corrected on or before 30 DAYS. Failure to comply with this order will result in a complaint being filed for prosecution in District Court.
