

Dear Ms. Kibbee:

Evaluation of the above complaint on May 13, 1985 revealed that, although the fire escape is not an object of beauty, structurally it appears to be stable, creating no hazard to the tenants if good judgement is used.

The hand rail must, however, have balusters installed at intervals not exceeding 6 inches on center to eliminate a potential accident hazard. This work should be done no later than June 21, 1985.
