Gentlemen:

For reasonable safety we recommend a second high limit aquastat between the flow valve and the boiler in connection with the oil burner which you are installing in the forced hot water heating system for Mrs. Eunice D. Argy at 43 Chestnut Street, this additional aquastat to be on duty in case of failure of the service aquastat, since, in such systems the room thermostat does not control the oil burner either directly or indirectly.

There have been cases where the service aquastat has failed.
