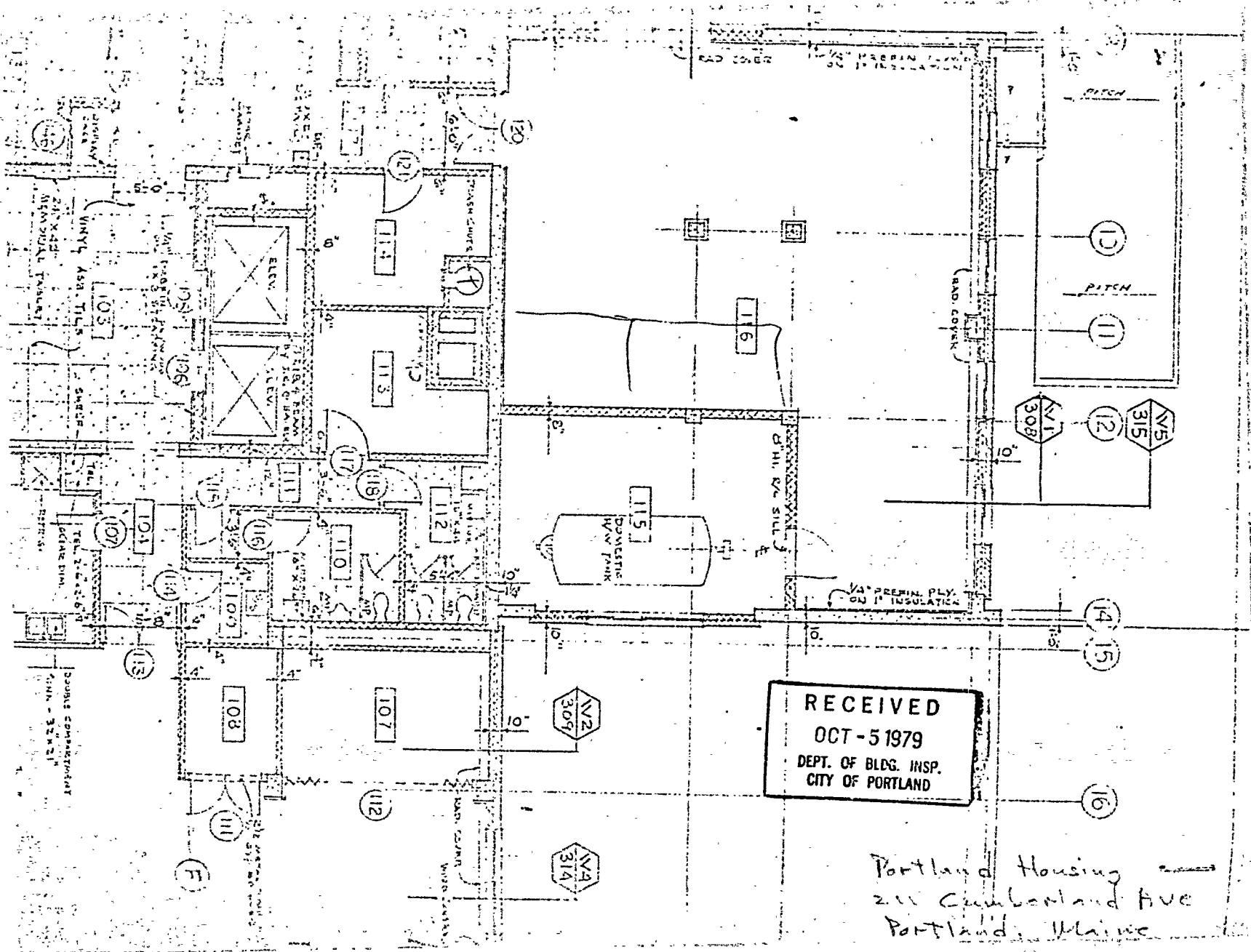

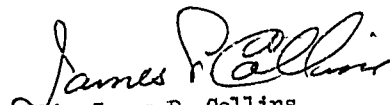

A permit has been issued, 76/1005, to erect 24 storage buildings, 6' x 8' at this housing development. 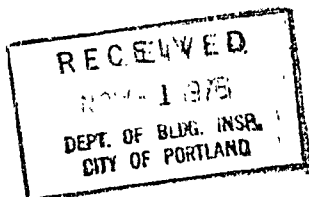

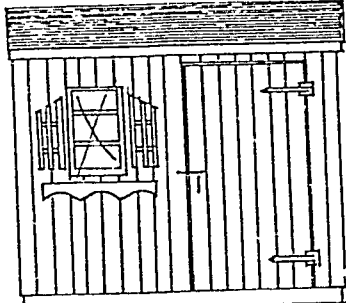

1. The contractor shall furnish and set up twenty-four (24) storage buildings in Bayside Terrace, Project ME 3-3.
2. The buildings shall be 6' deep x 8' wide.
3. Floor joist shall be 2" x 4" (spruce).
4. Rafters shall be 2" x 4" - 16" on center (spruce).
5. Floor and roof shall be pine or hemlock roofers.
6. Studs shall be 2" x 3" spruce - 16" on center.
7. Walls shall be Channel Rustic - pine.
8. Shingles shall be J.M. 235# S.O.M. Class C or equal.
9. Color of the shingles shall be as near the color as possible on dwelling units in Bayside Terrace.
10. All hardware and nails shall be galvanized.
11. Buildings shall have bolted hardware.
12. The buildings shall not have any windows.
13. The door shall be 32" wide.
14. The door shall be made of same material as walls.
15. The storage buildings shall be delivered to the site and set up in the backyards.
16. Buildings shall set level.
17. Each storage building shall be set on six (6) cement blocks - 8" x 8" x 16".
18. The contractor shall visit the site and determine for himself/themselves all conditions affecting the cost of the work before presenting his bid.
19. Any damage done to lawns, fences, etc., during the performance of setting up storage buildings shall be the responsibility of the contractor.

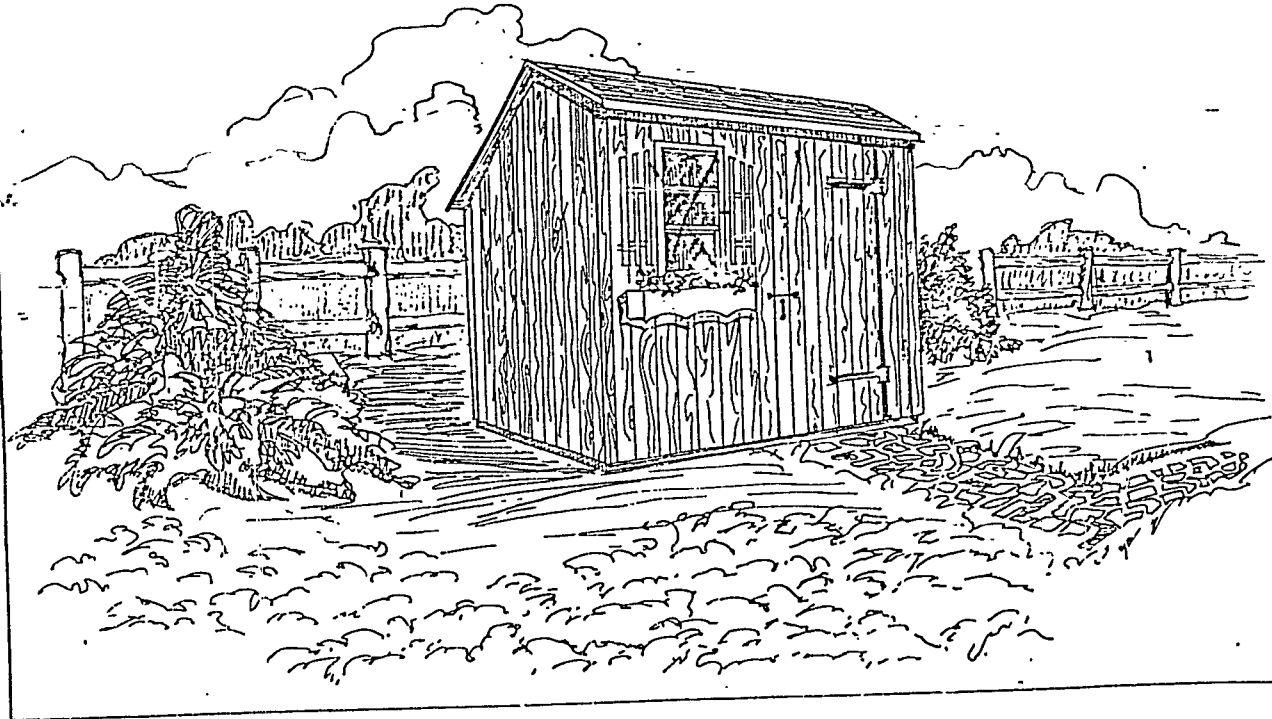
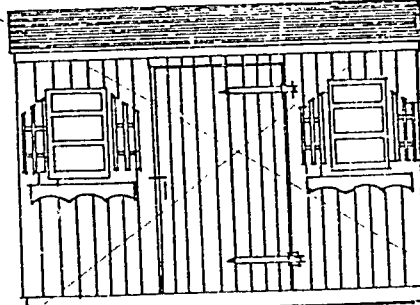

Dear Mr. Dexter:

Several months ago, you called to our attention the fact that the federal government would require Certificate of Occupancies for the public housing units now under construction by Stewart & Williams.

As you know, such a request represented a major obstacle for the City, since Certificate of Occupancies are only issued where our department has formally reviewed plans and conducted periodic inspections to determine compliance with the building codes & zoning ordinance.

In the case of the Housing Authority, it has always been reasoned that the federal government did not require local Building Department's approvals and inspections, since all public housing must be in compliance with minimum housing regulations established by the federal government and is subject to periodic inspection by federal inspectors.

To issue, therefore, a City of Portland Certificate of Occupancy does not appear proper in our judgement since we cannot honestly state that all integral parts of the buildings are in compliance with the City of Portland Building Codes and the Zoning Ordinances. We, however, recognize the dilemma faced by you, since the federal government is now adamant to the point that no occupancy will be allowed unless a local Certificate of Occupancy is issued.

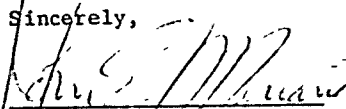
In order to assist you and without in the same process tarnishing the integrity of our Building Department or its inspectors, we are noting in this letter, which conveys the Certificate of Occupancy to you, that our inspections could only observe the finished product, since the structures were substantially complete when we were asked to furnish Certificates of Occupancies. The certificates which are issued, therefore, are issued without prejudice as to compliance with the Building Code and Zoning Ordinance of the City of Portland, Maine, based on visual observations and that the intent of the Building Code was complied with but without our knowledge as to interior construction compliances.

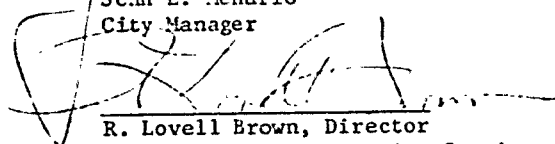

We find some comfort, however, that the architect involved has had considerable experience in the development of compatible units in Portland and that a reputable contractor was responsible for the work performed.

To make certain that a similar situation does not reoccur, we are formally notifying you through this letter that future public housing must secure a building permit from the City of Portland as per the Building Code, Section 303.1 and plans and work must be in compliance with the Building Code and Zoning Ordinance, and, therefore, subject to periodic field inspections and when completed, a Certificate of Occupancy will be issued.
