Re: 216-238 Fore Street - Fire Damage

Dear Mr. Brown:

A recent inspection was made by Code Enforcement Officer Arthur Addato of the property owned by you at 216-238 Fore Street. As a result of the inspection, you are ordered to correct the following hazardous structural conditions that exist: Notice of unsafe structure: If an unsafe condition is found in a building or structure, the building official shall serve on the owner, agent or person in control of the building or structure a written notice describing the building or structure deemed unsafe and specifying the required safe and secure, or requiring the unsafe building or structure or portion thereof to be demolished within a stipulated time. Such notice shall require the person thus notified to immediately declare to the building official his acceptance or rejection of the terms of the order.

The above mentioned conditions are in violation of Section 120.3 of the 1934 BOCA Building Code, and must be corrected on or before November 17, 1985. Failure to comply with this order may result in a complaint being filed for prosecution in District Court and a fine of \$50 to \$1,000 per day for each day these violations exist.
