3. In discussion with the Health Department it is required that if used rough barn boards are used they must be fumigated prior to being brought on the premises and used, in order to rid them of any possible vermin in the seams or holes.

4. The best of our knowledge the 4x12 fir for the 5x7 window as headers is satisfactory with the following exception. We do not have knowledge of the loading above and we feel that before these headers are installed we should be notified to see the condition and our inspector will look it over.

As a manner of comment, Mr. Gerber and I discussed on our return trip after visiting you on Friday A. M. it might be well for you to consider the use of a fire retardant paint on the ceiling joists and sandblasted plank areas. This is not considered mandatory but is worthy of your consideration against possible fire.

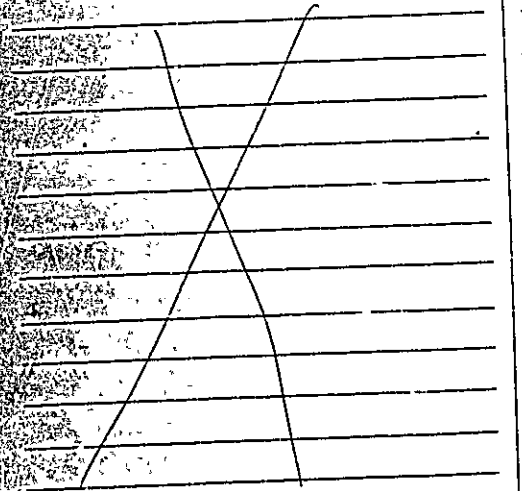
