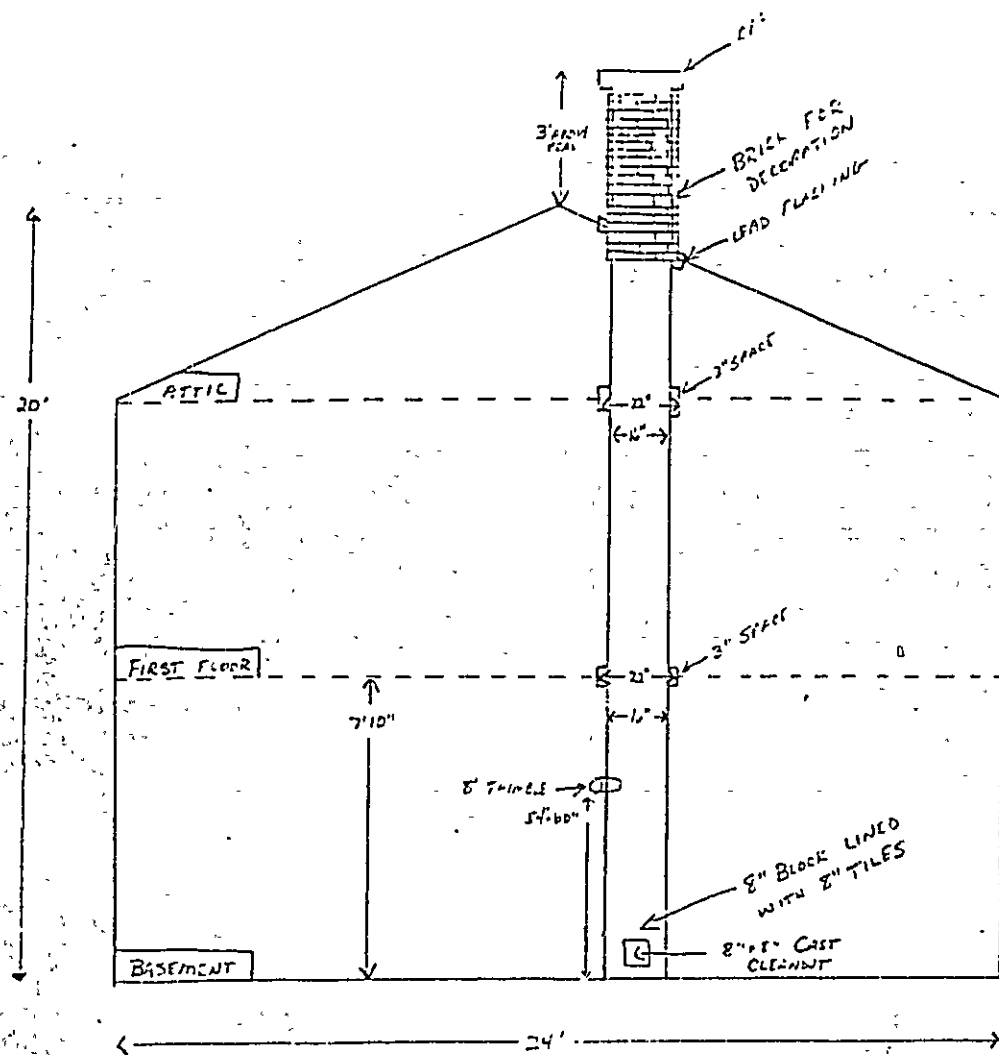

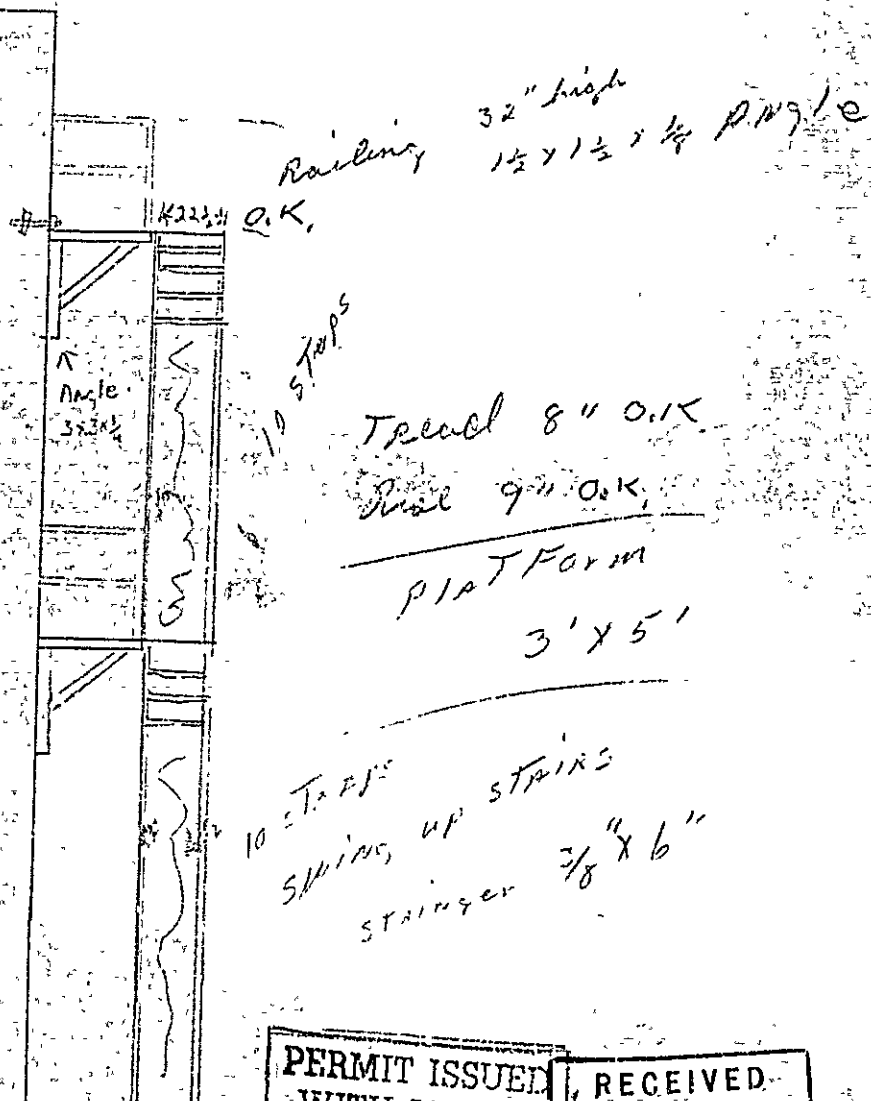
SIDE VIEW OF HOUSE
