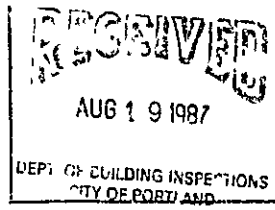

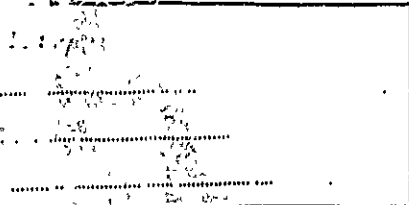

Section 322 BC of the "Municipal Code of the City of Portland, Maine" reads as follows:

"Submetering of Water Volume. Any person who feels that recorded water records are not a reliable index of his discharge volume may install an additional water meter of a type approved by the Director to measure the volume of water which can be shown not to enter the sewerage system. The person installing such a meter shall immediately notify the Director of such installation and shall be responsible to the Director for reporting meter readings not less often than every three months. Such person shall be credited with the volume charges for the volume shown by such meter, which meter shall be accessible for reading by the City or its agents at all reasonable times."

The City and the District have arranged to relieve the customer from the reporting responsibility required above if both meters can be read simultaneously by the District's meter readers during their regularly scheduled visits to read the general service meter. This can be accomplished by locating the sub-meter directly adjacent to the pre-existing service meter or by installing the sub-meter located elsewhere with a remote reading register located so data readings can be made at the same time.

Approved meters are, Ray, Ray and Rockwell meters, conforming to the following specifications:

1. shall meet or exceed A.S.T.M. accuracy test requirements and be accompanied by a certificate of test accuracy.

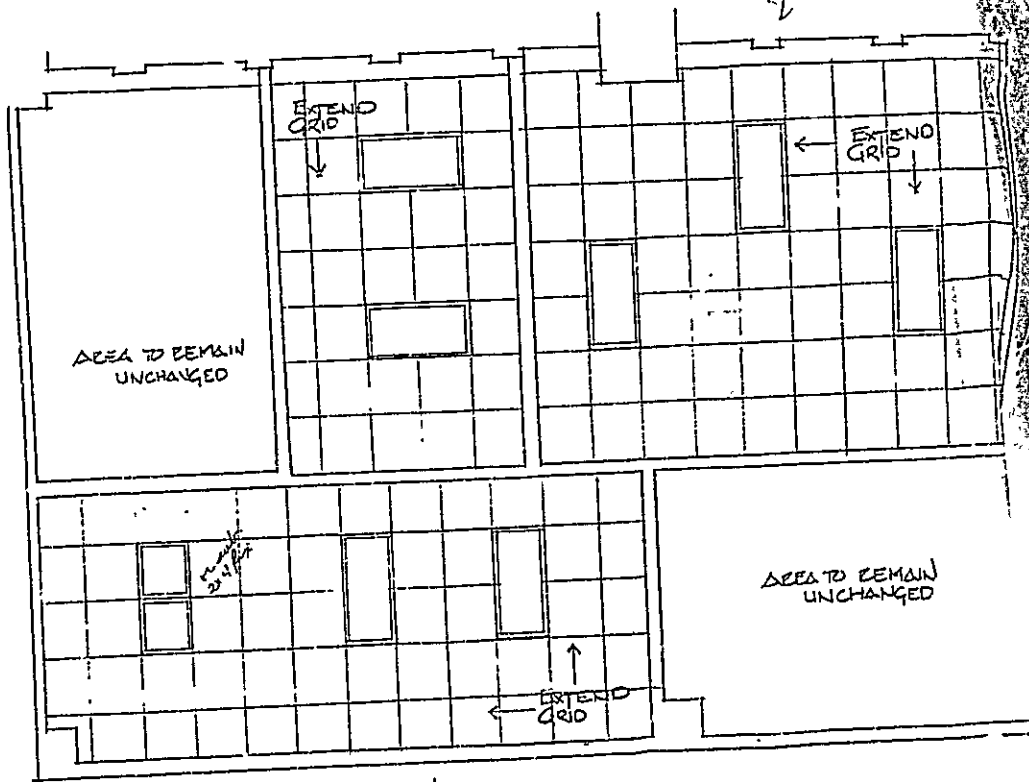
