I realize that Mr. Bramson is in the service, but I hope that I may receive in writing from him or from his representative answers to the following:

- 1. Provided the work complies with the Building Law and satisfies the Chief of the Fire Department as to exits, have you approved the arrangement shown for your helf of the building on the Tubby plane of March 16, 1943 (Revised April 2nd)? These plans indicate no change in the use of the first floor of your part. This matter has become so involved that it is not possible for this office to straighten it cut. In the meantime both sides of the building era being used without the alternate means of egress ordered by the Chief of the Fire Department, and the Bldg. Inspection Department must not be considered responsible for this delay. Most of my negotiations have been with the owners of the half of the building at 35 Alder, and I can give both of the Wood brothers credit for trying to do semething, but after all of these months we have not jet even had an application for a building permit to cover construction of the rear fire escapes.

It seems evident that an offort is being made to work out a joint fire escape to serve both sides of the building, and perhaps that accounts for some of the delay. Another cause of delay is the first that we find that the building owned by the Mooi's bas been converted from a single family dwelling house to a combined rooming and opertment house at scattime since 1926 without a permit or certificate of occupancy being secured and without complying with the provisions for safety of the building law in effect at the time the change was made. Whether or not the Braneon side of the building was also so illegally changed I am not sure, but it seems evident that both sides of the building are in about the name category. The Wood's employed Mr. Tubby to make plans of their side of the building showing the arrangement of apartments and a new means of egress to serve both older of the building. Mr. Tubby brought the plans of this proposition into the office and I must over them with him at some length, there being same matters which did not satisfy Building Code requirements. There seems to have been same disagreement strong the Wood's as regards to what thould be done and as regards the disposal of a more or less dilapidated or rear ell. Both of the Wood brothers have been in the office at different times and talked the matter over with me. Mrs. Wood, the mother, has phoned me about the pressition; and there has been some talk of changing the Wood side back into a two family duelling house.

As authorized and directed by Section 109-a of the Building Gode of the City of Portland, you are hereby directed to have the two-story rear ell (used as a shed) and the two-story open plazza as above thoroughly and persenently repaired and strengthened, or built so as to be undoubtedly safe and sound, or demoliahed not later than August 25, 1943, copy of Section of Building Code mentioned, enclosed herewith. In the counting in order to escupe possible injury to persons and liability on your part, it would be well to notify all of the occupants of the building and post a notice at all entrances of the two-story porch to the affort that the plazzas are sucondingly questionable as to safety and that persons using them do so at their own risk. If necessary to maintain the troastory shed, it is quite possible that this part of the structure may be regained and strengthened, probably equipping with a new foundation (this would have to be a masonry foundation, either wall or piero); but it seems apparent that the side plazza '111 have to be removed and completely rebuilt. A building permit from this department is required before this work is commenced, both operations may be covered in one permit. If the rear shed is to be demolished, description of that operation is sufficient on the applie tion and a description should also be included as to what is to be done about closing in and reviding permanent weather covering for the part of the main building exposed when the shed is removed, also as to whether or not there is any cellar under the shed now, and if so, what is to be fine to close the collar under the main building. with regard to the piazzas, a plan must be filed with the application for the permit to a definite scale, showing all the details of the proposed reconstruction. including foundation, sizes, special and opens of all supporting members, how the piezza is to be supported upon and fastoned to the sain building, etc. This pish should be made by a person thoroughly experienced in making plans, one who is accomminted with the usual mothod of designing foundations, and structural members, and acquainted with the Building Code requirements relating thereto. The plans should be filed as a blueprint with all of the information on it printed from the original. while portage not inmediately dangerous the following matters should because attention as soon as possible in the collar. The chimney in the main house has so e sracks in the masonry wall thich should be repaired and each flue in the chimney chould be equipped with a cost iron clean-out door and frame, the flues theroughly cleaned out, and all former openings in the collar now stopped with otal plugs, tichtly bricked in. Over some sections of the coller at least there has existed a wooden floor, there are holes in this floor in places and the receral condition of this floor and the balance of the cellar is such as to couse fire mearc. If the mooden floor is erving no useful purpose, it tay be possible to remove it. At any rate, the entire coller ought to be overhauled and cleared up to elimin te fire hazerd. Referring to our telephone conversation on the above subject, I am enclosing confess of my letter of August 9, 1945 to Lawrence C. Food, at als, and also of my letter of the same data representing an order with regard to the rear ell and the open perchase a result of a complaint filed by myself on account of the condition of these parts of the structure.

As soon as you have had tire to digest this situation and your client has reashed some conclusion as to that he will do, I shall appreciate notice in writing of his conclusions on both scows, -- the prepared use of the building and the repair, rebuilding of demolition of two defective parts of the structure.

As stated in my letter, it is my believe that the only solution of the purch problem is to remote it, have a plan of a new perch made by a competent man who don designe such structures in the light of Building Code requirements then have the proposed duilder file the plan in the way of a blue-print with all of the information on it printed from the original at this office with an application for a permit to cover the reconstruction. Much the same procedure would apply if the new awner desires to rebuild or satisfactorally improve the structure of the dilapidated shed.

We are having a great doul of difficulty with these defective structures, especially perches, because the owner attempts to commize on faving plans made. As a consequence, we get plans in here which are not intelligible and will not werve the purposes of the Building Code unless there is remebody in hand at all times to explain the plan. Then well can see the uselessness of such plans for our records.
