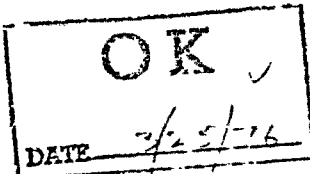

We recently received a complaint and an inspection was made by Housing Inspector Gough of the property owned by you at 578 Congress Street, Portland, Maine. As a result of the inspection, you are hereby ordered to correct the following substandard housing conditions:

1. Provide a minimum temperature of at least 68 degrees Fahrenheit, at a distance of three feet above floor level, as required by prevailing weather conditions from Sept. 15th through May 15th of each year. (2) 9-b
2. Install a sink for the kitchen. (2) 6-a

The above mentioned conditions are in violation of Chapter 307 of the Municipal Code of the City of Portland, Maine, and must be corrected on or before December 8, 1975.
