We recently received a complaint and an inspection was made by Code Enforcement Officer K. A. Taylor of the property owned by you at 131 State Street.

Portland, Maine. As a result of the inspection, you are hereby ordered to correct the following substandard housing conditions:

- 1. Heating facilities required. Every habitable room excepting rooms used primarity for sleeping purposes shall be served by heating facilities capable of providing a minimum temperature of 68° at a distance of 3 feet above floor level as required by prevailing weather conditions from September 15 to May 15 of each year. 114-2 = 24 kgc pic closed.
- 1. APARTMENT #14 BEDROOM wall damaged. 108-2

The above mentioned conditions are in violation of Article V o' the Municipal Code of the City of Portland, Maine, and must be corrected on or before Item #1, February 18 and Item #2, March 17, 1987.
