During a recent inspection of the property owned by you at 5-7 Deering Street, Portland, Maine , it was noted that scake detectors were missing/inoperable in some locations.

25 MRSA 2464 requires that approved snoke detectors be installed in each apartment in the immediate vicinity of the bedrooms. When actuated, the selector shall provide an alarm suitable to warn the occupants within the individual unit. Failure to comply with this statute may result in a fine of up to \$500 for each violation.

Re-inspection of your property will be made in ten (10) days. Lack of compliance will result in referral of the matter for legal action.
