Gontlemen:

The only change which has meen discovered on the revised location plan of Maine Medical Center (. ) sived here with Mr. Clark's letter of March 9) over the former location plan received here early in February, is the showing of the relocated garage in rear of the existing dwelling house facing Brawhall St.

In this connection your attention is called to Sect. 209b2 of the Code, which indicates that exterior walls of Type A hospitals closer than 16 feet to another building on property of the same ownership shall be as required for separations of two-hour fire resistance with standard fireresistive windows allowed.

The dwelling house appears to be closer than lo feet to the corner of the proposed building and the location proposed for the garage scales just about 16 feet from the end of the wing. As far as I can see this would only mean that all windows in the new building in any part of the wall closer than 16, feet to any other building would have to be standard fire-resistive windows, normally metal sash with wire glass.

We have some reviews of the hospital requirements underway, but whether there will be any change in this particular cannot be told now.




