

Re-inspection of your property will be made in ten (10) days. Lack of compliance will result in referral of the matter for legal action.





FOR YOUR INFORMATION

the following excerpts are from Article V of the City of Portland Housing Code regulating "Minimum Standards for Housing."

SECTION 107 - MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR DWELLINGS ESTABLISHED

Inere are horeby established minimum standards for buildings used for dwelling purposes in the City. All such buildings not now conforming to these standards will be required to meet such minimum standards, and buildings newly constructed or converted for such purposes shall meet such minimum standards. The standards set forth herein are intended to be minimum only and shall not be construed otherwise, nor shall they apply wherever a greater standard is required by any other ordinance or law. (Code 1968, \$307.1)

SECTION 125 - RESTRICTION G.: CUNVEYANCE OF PROPERTY; EXCEPTION.

It shall be a violation of this article for any person to sell, transfer, or otherwise dispose of any property acainst which an order has been issued by the building authority under the provisions of this article unless he or she shall first furnish to the grantee a true copy of any such order and shall at the same time notify the building authority in writing of the intent to so transfer either by delivering the notice to the building authority and receiving a receipt therefor or by registered mail, return receipt requested, giving the name and address of the person to whom the transfer is proposed. In the event of a violation of this section, such person shall be subject to a penalty as provided in section 1-15, ir addition to any penalty which may be imposed for failure to comply with any order of the building authority. (Code 1968, §307.19)

SECTION 126 - RESPONSIBILITY HEREUNDER MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED.

No contract or agreement between owner and/or operator and occupant relating to compliance with the terms of this article shall be effective in relieving any person of responsibility for compliance with the provisions of this article as set forth herein. (Code 1968 §307.20)

SECTION 130 - VIGLATIONS

Any person violating any of the provisions of this article or failing or neglecting or refusing to obey any order or notice of the building authority issued hereunder shall be subject to a penalty as provided in section 1-15. (Code 1968, \$307.24; Ord. No. 133-75, 2-19-75) (a fine of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$1,000.00 and each day's violation shall be considered to be a separate offense.)
