

### VARIANCE APPEAL

Nay 12, 1964

C. A. Pierce Company , owner of property at 192 Brackett Street under the provisions of Section 24 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Portland, hereby respectfully petitions the Board of Appeals for a variance from the provisions of said Ordinance to permit: erection of a 3 x 4 attached sign which overhangs the sidewalk approximately 6 x 6". This permit is presently not issuable under the Zoning Ordinance because proposed sign is in violation of Section 16=A=4=a which allows only signs flat against the building in the B-1 Business Zone in which this sign is located.

LEGAL BASIS OF APPEAL: Such variance may be granted only if the Board of Appeals finds that the strict application of the provisions of the Ordinance would result in undue hardship in the development of property which is inconsistent with the intent and purpose of the Ordinance; that there are exceptional or unique circumstances relating to the property that do not generally apply to other property in the same zone or neighborhood, which have not arisen as a result of action of the applicant subsequent to the adoption of this Ordinance whether in violation of the provisions of the Ordinance or not; that property in the same zone or neighborhood will not be adversely affected by the granting of the variance; and that the granting of the variance will not be contrary to the intent and purpose of the Ordinance.

### DECISION


